

No-Prep Veneers and Digital Photography

Naoki Aiba, CDT, Oral Design is a graduate of the Dental Technology Program at the Dental School of Aichi Gakuin University in Nagoya, Japan, and has worked extensively in both the United States and Japan. Among his many awards and recognitions is the prestigious "Young Speaker of the Year Award" presented to him by Dr. John McLean, OBE of the International Society for Dental Ceramists. Mr. Aiba has lectured and conducted seminars in more than 20 countries on ceramic restorations, dental photography and dentist-laboratory aesthetic communications. He is a current member of the Oral Design Group and has his laboratory in Monterey, California. Mr. Aiba lectures extensively in the USA and abroad on Esthetic Dentistry.



This course will explore the methods and practicality of creating feldspathic restorations to be used in specific esthetic cases. Situations such as diastema closure, rotation problems, and Buccal/Lingual angulation can often be corrected with minimally invasive, no-prep veneers. In this two day clinical and lecture course, we will define the ideal patients for treatment, the steps needed to create these restorations, as well as have a live clinical demonstration on proper seating, cementation, and finishing techniques. Additionally, this course will provide instruction on Custom Shade Taking, Digital Photography, and Smile Design.

Proper case selection, quality shade selection, and careful insertion lead to a harmonious result, and a more natural smile.
